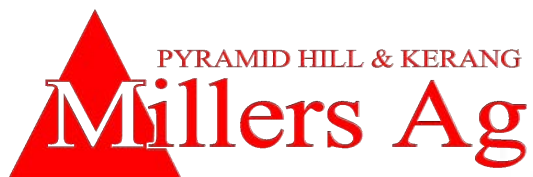
The night concluded with a birthday cake for those who most recently celebrated their 70th birthday, accompanied by singing and blowing (clapping) out of candles.

BOWLS NOTES

Surprise, surprise!

We even surprised ourselves with our **Mid-week Pennant** successes last week. Having been washed out for the first round we were chomping at the bit to get into the swing of things and relished the opportunity to play at home on the greens that Bill, Joe, Carmen and Allan had given so much time and toil.

Division 1 took on the dynamic Kerang side and came out victorious on two of the three rinks and an overall tally (82-72) that left us feeling more buoyant than a boat in a bottle. Roma (Skip), Ian, Terry and Peter C. created a good lead from the get go and remained steady in their endeavour never allowing their opponents to get even a sniff of a win. Their highest margin was 12 shots up mid-match and they only conceded the last two ends to let this advantage slip back to 8 shots (25-17). Marie S. (Skip), Ted, Marie N. and Kate took a couple of ends to find their range but by the 6th end they had taken control thanks to some amazing shots from the Skip and third players in particular, although every player was in for the kill. Their 33-21 victory was a significant achievement against top quality opposition and enabled them to lay claim to the "Froggo Award." Tony C., Marg, Jan and Rose had their heads down and tails up as they fought to gain some ascendancy which they did mid-way through the 25 ends. They built a handy 6 shot lead at the 17th end but then squandered this by never scoring for the last eight ends to finish 24-34 in arrears. A highlight of their match was a 7 shot haul on the 15th end – only one PH bowl was not in the count. It was a fantastic start to the season and gives us something to build upon knowing that we are "no mugs and a force to be reckoned with".

Division 2 had a couple of exciting games. Lorraine's team of George (lead), Robyn and Bill had a good start which was soon counteracted with consecutive ends going to Barham. By midway through it was looking quite disastrous as the opposition had accumulated a 12 shot lead before the local team came home with a wet sail to be only 3 down on the last end; but unfortunately with the last bowl of the match victory went to Barham 4 shots up 24-28. On the other rink Dawn and her team, Wayne (lead), Dorothy and Joe absolutely bolted out of the blocks and gained and maintained a lead of 10 shots for much of the match, compensating for the other rink's deficit at that stage – overall not much separating the two teams. But just as Lorraine's team was surging forward,

Dawn's team was declining their lead to be reduced to just 3 on the final end. However they prevailed with 2 more shots to win by 5, covering the 4 shot shortfall for an overall win to the side by 1 shot. Great work!

Saturday Pennant: The news was not so glowing although we still all gave it a good red hot shot.

Division 2: The outcome of the game against Cohuna Golf 3 kept us all enthralled for quite the journey. It was a special day for Lionel who helped his rink of players (Jean, Ray P. & Kate) get over the line with four more shots than their opponents. They toiled along consistently but were thwarted from scoring any big numbers which kept their opponents ever within reach, however they earned two points for the club aggregate by winning 22-18. Ted, in his new role as Skip, guided his rink of players (Bill, Terry & Joe) to a very-almost victory. A fine buffer of 7 shots on one end was nearly enough to see them through but, alas, they fell short by two measly shots (24-26). Jan (Skip), Marie N., Ian & Rose were right in the game until the opposition turned up the heat. Giving away 5 shots on one end and 6 shots on another was sinful and caused their demise to go down 18-29. Overall Cohuna Golf had 73 shots to Pyramid Hill's 64. The difference of 9 shots was a creditable effort.

Division 3: were pitted against Kerang Golf for the second round of competition. Ironically 3 of their players were substitute players for us the previous week and were now part of the formidable opposition. Unable to field a full side of 12 players, one rink drew the short straw to play with only 3 in their team. Being the only winning rink the previous week it was Tony B with Robyn and George (lead) also meeting a team of three from Kerang Golf, so it was a much fairer match-up. The battle was on for most of the match with not much separating them until the final stages when the opposition took control and ran out winners by 10 shots, 17-27. Lorraine's team of Ray B. A late resurgence tidied up the tally a little but it was still a final deficit by 13 shots, 18-31. 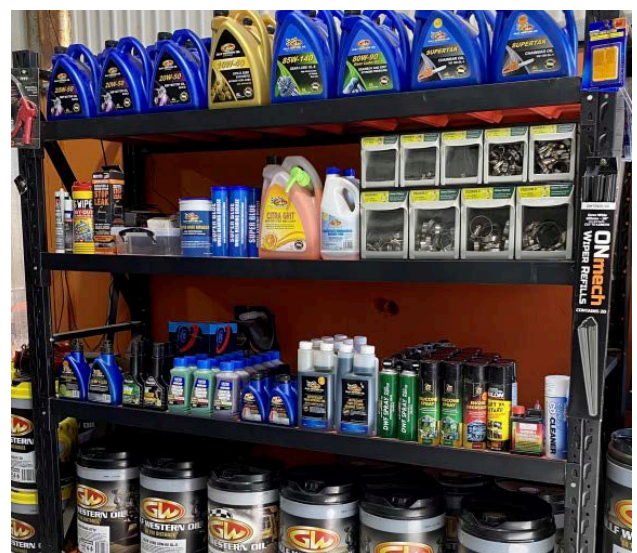
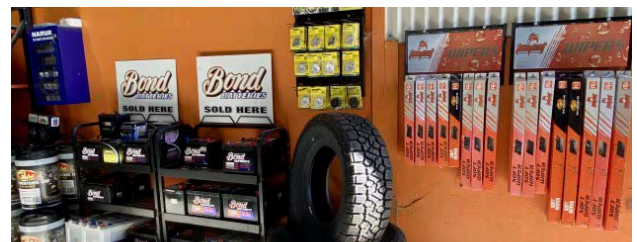
