## Pre-Historic Pre Schoolers!

We were lucky enough to have Foti & Selwyn visit Pyramid Hill Pre-School from the Melbourne Museum. They introduced us to 3 different types of dinosaurs - *Brachiosaurus*, *Triceratops*, & the *Tyrannosaurus Rex*.

Presenter Selwyn is deaf, so he taught us how to speak with our hands (Auslan). We learnt the person who digs up dinosaur bones is called a Paleontologist. When the bones have been in the dirt for a long, long time, they turn into rock and we call them fossils. Next, some volunteers helped Foti carry in large fossils of a leg from a life-sized Tsintaosaurus dinosaur. Look how big it is compared to us! It would not have been able to fit in our kinder if it were still alive today. Next, Foti showed us the skull of a Tsintaosaurus dinosaur. We were able to touch it, feel the teeth, and put our hands in its eye sockets. How cool is that? We also got a chance to explore smaller fossils. There were teeth, cephalopods and dinosaur poo! Finally, we measured how many children it would take to make one dinosaur leg! It was a wonderful experience to have the team from Melbourne Museum visit us. The children were able to engage in hands-on learning and we were lucky enough to have Selwyn teach us Auslan too.

## Football Notes: Round 8

The round 8 trip to Inglewood started in ideal weather, but ended in true winter conditions. One thing that did stay hot though were the on-field performances of the Demons. For the first time this season the Club song was belted out by all 3 football teams and their support staff.

The Under 18s claimed their first “four-point” result and they did it in the best possible way; leading at every change. Bryden and Luke have shown great faith in their young squad and finally the boys were able to repay their coaches and a large crowd of family and supporters. Led by Harry Goodes with great work between the fifty-metre arcs, and Blake Gibson as a roving back-line general, the boys were able to continually provide opportunities and the goals flowed; 11 to be exact.

Lewis Stubbs (Good Sports Award) was a focal point over 4 quarters and his four goals were a reward for his positive attack on the ball. At ground level he was supported by Connor McCoy who nailed 3 goals of his own. Xavier Emmerson was a physical presence and his efforts made sure his smaller teammates were able to win plenty of the “Sherrin”. Harry Goodes again carried the ball valuable distances each time he gained possession, and with 3 goals he was a fitting recipient of the (Victoria Hotel Pizza Award). James Hercott is another player who continues to develop and his efforts were noticeable across the entire game. Blake Gibson (Pyramid Hill Butcher Award) was again at his best, demonstrating a great ability to read the ball and be in the right position at the right time. A few of the boys needed some assistance with a few lines of the Club song, but, based on this performance, all members are sure that this won't be the last time it is belted out this season.

The Bulldogs “Ressies”, in beating their Inglewood counterparts, again claimed the scalp of a team higher on the ladder, and the reward was a move up the ladder to 3 rd . Coach Stephen Donat was again at his smiling best in the rooms, and reflected on the great team effort in the final quarter. The Bulldogs piled on 4-4-28 and kept the hosts to a solitary minor score. The win was again set up by tireless work in the corridor by Tom Walker (Pony Award). Hard-ball gets, effective disposal and the much appreciated “1 percenters” are signature on-field acts and Tom continues to show the way. Dylan Lovell was his customary livewire self across half forward, and whether in the air or at ground level he won more than his share of the contests. Two goals was a fitting return, as was the “National Hotel Award”. Due to injury Jack Burns had been forced to watch from the sidelines, but a great clubman, who is a regular at all our games, showed teammates the wait was worthwhile. A hard-running, full-on four quarter effort

was appreciated by those on and off the field. The “Victoria Hotel Award” was fitting recognition for his full-on efforts across the entire game. The “Good Sports Award” went to Matt Moon who not only provided his customary rebound efforts, but was also able to deliver and switch the ball, with breaking the lines made easier for teammates. Inside the forward fifty arc Mitch Dingwall (3 goals) was back to his damaging best, and with Mark Swiney, who again hit the scoreboard, were able to ensure a winning score was posted. Kaleb Quinn, hard at it and prepared to win the hard ball, Ashton Dye, back from an injury layoff, and Tom Boyer, Dolf Reid and 1 st -game player Lennox Barker all made valuable contributions in what was a top victory away from home.

In what was another emphatic team effort a standout feature was the preparedness to get numbers in support at the stoppages and keep pressure on the opposition. It was a good way to enter the “King's Birthday Bye Round”. 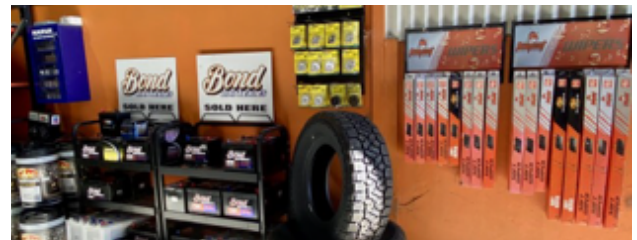
