Who remembers these wonderful little recipe books?! Today I have chosen a couple of.. savoury.. delights. Please let me know if anyone has a go at the rabbit dish..

CRUSTY SEASONED RABBIT

- 1 Rabbit
- 1 and 1/2 cups breadcrumbs
- 1 small onion
- 1 oz. margarine
- 1 cup of milk
- 1 packet chicken noodle soup

Method: Soak rabbit in salted water, disjoint, dry and roll in seasoned flour and then place in greased casserole. Mix breadcrumbs, onion [finely chopped] and margarine together then sprinkle over rabbit. Add chicken noodle soup and milk and bake in a moderate oven for one hour. Remove lid and bake a further 1/2 hour.

ONION TART

- 2lbs. Onions
- 3 eggs
- 4 tablespoons sherry
- Flaky pie crust
- 3 tablespoons butter
- 1 cup cream
- Bacon

Method: Cook thinly sliced onions in butter until transparent. Cool thoroughly, stir in one cup cream mixed with 4 tablespoons sherry and 3 well beaten eggs. Season to taste [add some nutmeg or thyme]. Line a 9" pie plate with pastry. Fill with onion mixture and cut up 4 slices back into cubes and place on top. Bake in moderate oven until filling is firm. Serve as hot as possible.

PYRAMID HILL & DISTRICT HISTORICAL SOCIETY 2024 PRESIDENT'S REPORT

The Historical Society held their AGM last week, with no change to the positions of office, other than Helen Stevens stepping down from her official capacity as Archivist. Helen attended the meeting, and will remain involved in a lesser capacity with research and cataloguing. Allan Mann was again elected President, and submits his Annual Report.

It is with much pleasure I put to you a brief report for years ending June 2024. With the completion of the administration room and new computers purchased, it provides a much improved environment for our volunteers to keep the facility functioning. Also the program to put thirty plus plaques around the town is complete, thanks to FRRR and the volunteers who installed them. In our display we have valuable and irreplaceable items, and it has been noted that such items could be stolen. To protect such items, a security system has been installed. We thank the Op Shop for the \$2200 donation towards the cost.

In November we made the Barber Street project our No 1 Priority Project. Also in November we teamed up with the Progress Association and raised \$7800 to modernize the Store Clock. Thanks to Trevor McIntosh for the installation. On the 27th March a meeting was held with Bronwyn Hogan and Matt O'Bree from ESP in Swan Hill with an inspection of the site and our collection of items.

In May we were told the GMW land and buildings would be sold. The committee decided it was worth further investigation. A motion was passed that we ask ESP to assist us in putting in an expression of interest to purchase the site. We recently applied for DGR status, meaning donations can be tax deductible. At long last we launched the SCOTS WHA HAE - the history of the Caledonian Society and Pipe Band. What a day it was, pipers returning home and from Bendigo. For all that, I must thank the Committee and volunteers for services rendered. Volunteering means giving up something else. I must thank Secretary Cheryl McKinnon for her professional approach at a time when that is needed. The number of people seeking historical information is proof of our amazing collection of artifacts and written history, which is always in demand. Recently we were saddened by the passing of Margaret Williamson, a long time member. Her search for history, and then to put it into print for everyone to benefit was amazing. Her contribution will live on and never be forgotten.

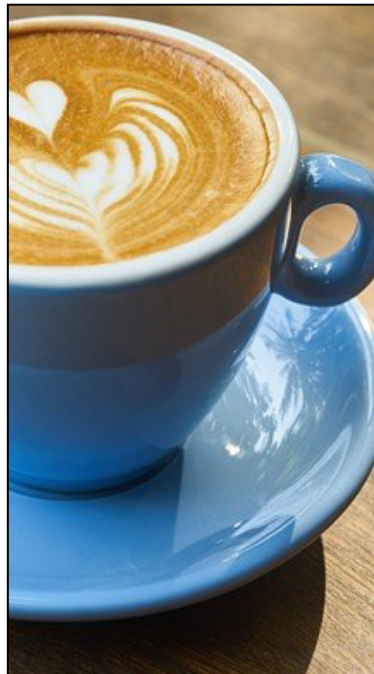
