Hostel Back in our Hands!



In a significant development for Pyramid Hill, the closed Pyramid Hill Hostel, formerly owned and operated by not-for-profit aged care provider Respect, has been officially gifted back to the Pyramid Hill community.

The historic agreement was finalised during a meeting on Wednesday 7 May, between Jason Binder, Managing Director and CEO of Respect, Drew Chislett, President of the Pyramid Hill Progress Association, and Nev Miller, previous president and local businessman.

This landmark decision reflects a strong commitment to enhance the social fabric of Pyramid Hill, ensuring that older people in the local community can continue to live in familiar surroundings. The plan is to transform the former hostel into an independent living complex, allowing seniors to maintain their independence while remaining close to family and friends.

At the Progress meeting last night at the Victoria Hotel, Drew and Nev discussed the positive negotiations they have had with Respect Aged Care CEO, Jason Binder, and spoke about his enthusiasm for Pyramid Hill to once again take control of the facility.

In coming weeks there will be meetings held with the community to fully define how we go forward with the facility, including the re-establishment of a management structure /Trust, and a working bee!

The first community planning meeting will be held at the Victoria Hotel on Wednesday 6th June! This meeting will be for those interested in joining a working party to inform the next stages..

Key handover is due to happen on 1st July. Read the Loddon Herald for more details!

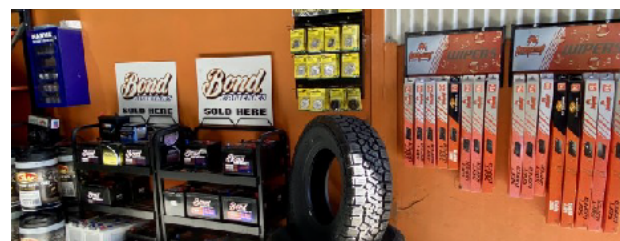

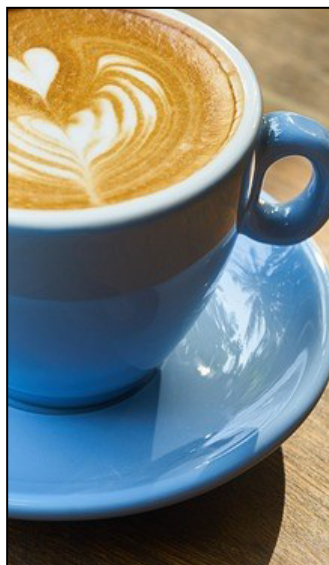

A few folk even managed to do some Live Scoring (when the mobile phones behaved themselves) which is an interesting forerunner of things to come.

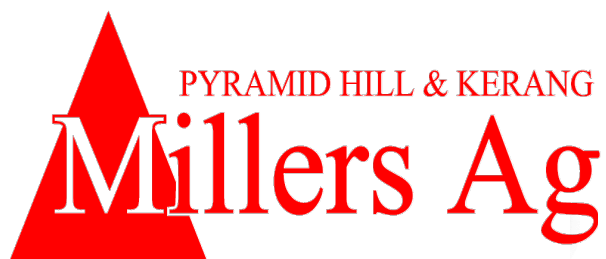
