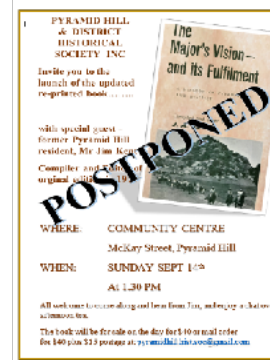
## Book Launch Postponed

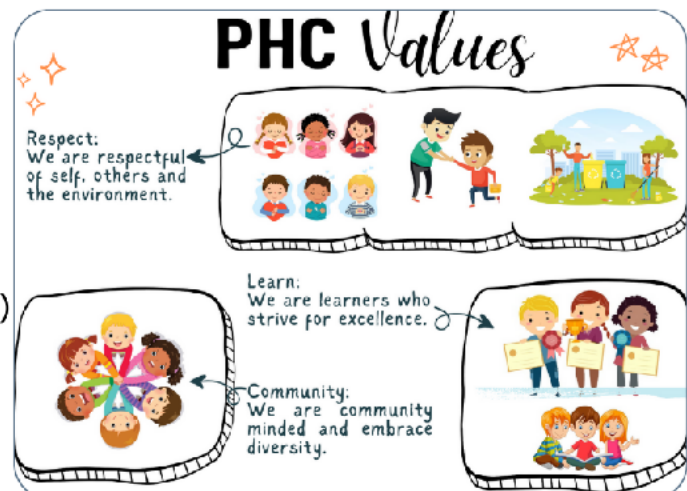

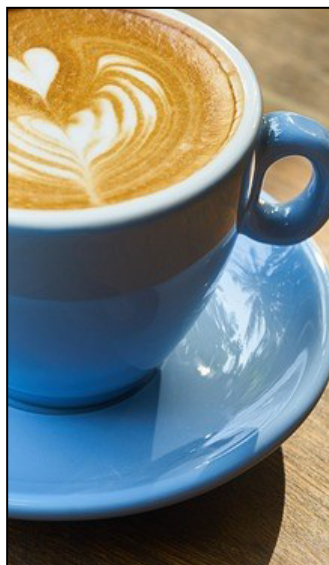

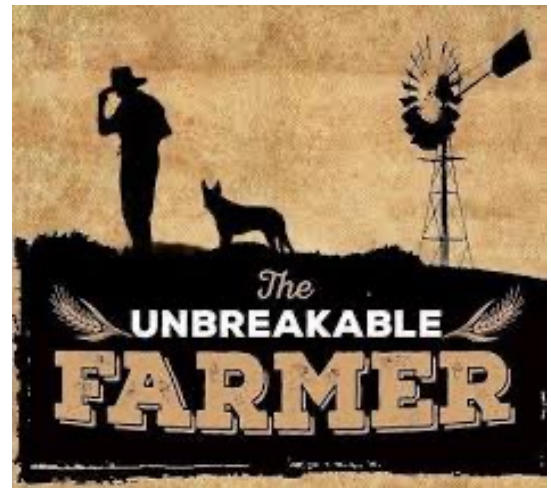
