Pyramid Hill hit the national headlines this week with the story of Daniel Kelly, who has broken his leg after disembarking from the VLine train... into thin air at Pyramid Hill train station!

We have a short platform at the Pyramid Hill Station, it's true. But I suppose when a door opens - you expect a solid landing place when you step out!

Daniel waited for an ambulance for over an hour - but when it was taking far too long.. he was hauled back onto the train and taken to Kerang where he waited for an ambulance.

He finally arrived at Bendigo Hospital at 3am in the morning where he had surgery to stabilise his broken leg with rods.

Currently there is an investigation into the incident by the Office of the National Rail Safety Regulator.



Peter Walsh has also weighed in with comments about the incident and also an acknowledgement of Ambulance wait times being far too long.



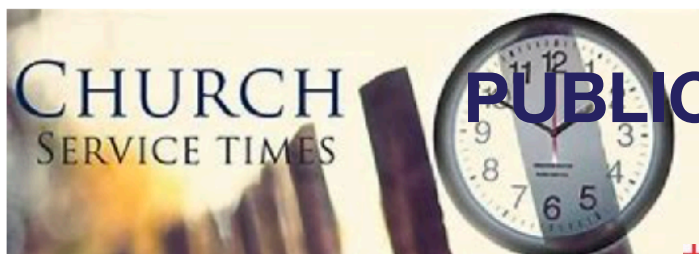

R U Okay Day: Together We Care

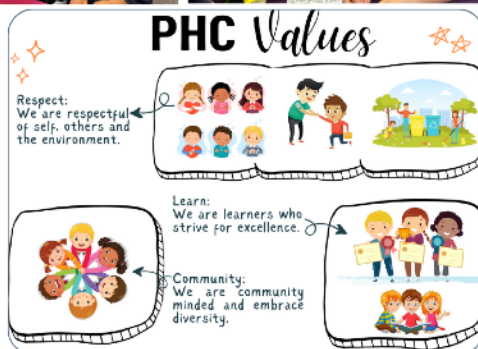

The Loddon Healthy Minds Network commends all participants for their creativity and the powerful messages expressed through their art.

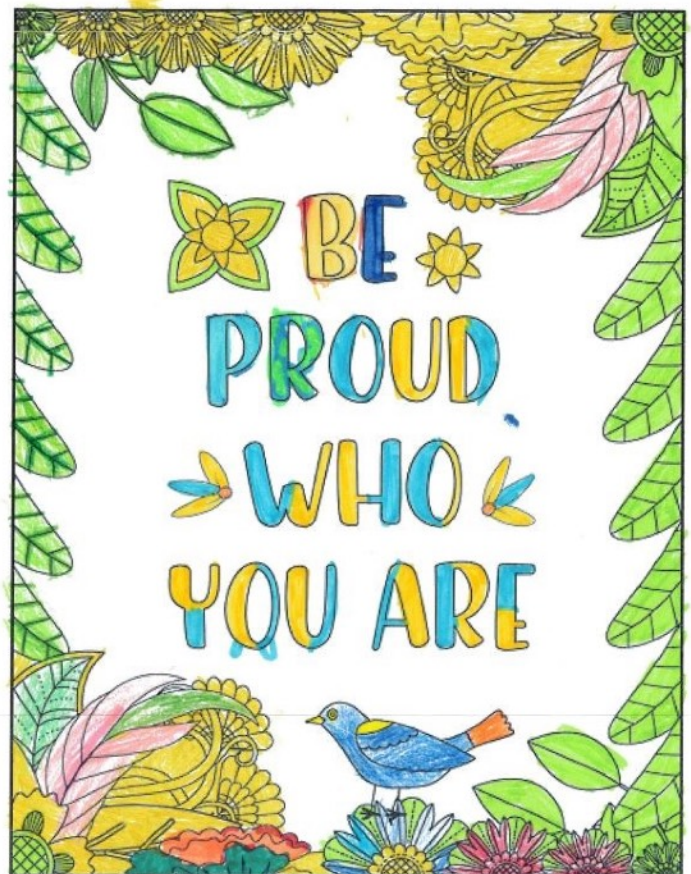
